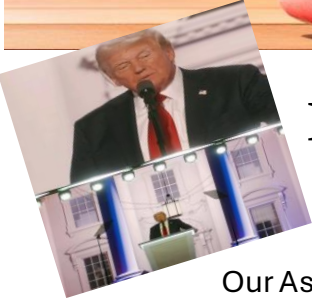

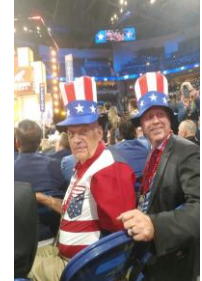

He had the honor of serving on the RNC Credentials Committee where he spoke on the rules and adherence to making sure all delegates who attended the convention were properly elected at their State Conventions. Kevin was joined by many members of the Oregon Republican Party including MHRW member Joanna Harbour who is currently running for US Congress in the Oregon 3rd Congressional District.
